

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS & BIDS

Environmental Remediation Project

New London, CT

Renaissance City Development Association (RCDA) and the City of New London, CT are seeking bid proposals from qualified firms for environmental remediation of vacant parcels located at the corner of Howard and Hamilton Streets in New London, CT. The subject parcels are further identified as Parcel 5C1 (Map F15, Block 101, Lot 5C1) and Parcel 5C2 (Map F15, Block 101, Lot 5C2). The proposed work is being funded through USEPA Brownfield Cleanup Grant # 96181801 and consists of remediation of a tidal ditch and former solid waste disposal area.
