Sewer Rebate Program

The Department may issue a sewer rebate to customers able to demonstrate use of water which does not enter the sewer system. Sewer rebates will only be processed where the volume of water requested for rebate is equal to or greater than 1000 CF.

Criteria for claims: Customers must apply for a sewer rebate at the Department of Public Utilities, following the instructions for providing proof of water usage, including installation of additional approved meter equipment if required. Deduct meters, where required, must be installed, maintained, and read by the customer subject to inspection by the Department personnel. The meter must conform to the same standard as the billable account meter specifications.

(1) Pool Filling: A rebate may be issued for the purpose of pool filling as long as the water does not enter the sewer system. Draining of pools into the sewer system at any time is not allowed. Customers should call the Department of Public Utilities Billing Office and schedule an appointment to have the measurements of the pool taken. The quantity of water shall be established by separate metering installed at the customer's expense, or by proper engineering calculation, as required by the Director.

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- (2) Irrigation System: A rebate may be issued if the customer participates in a deduction program for irrigation purposes. Customers will be required to have a deduct meter installed by a license plumber or irrigation company authorized to install plumbing work for irrigation. The meter must be located on the irrigation line. A rebate form must be submitted to the Department of Public Utilities Billing Office annually. Please note that an irrigation system must comply with additional requirements as dictated by the Cross Connection Manual issued by the Connecticut Department of Public Health.
- (3) Other: The Director shall have the authority to review documentation and issue a sewer rebate in other circumstances where customers are able to demonstrate use of water which does not enter the sewer system.

Waterford users.

For sewage delivered through the Waterford force main, charges shall be made in accordance with the New London/Waterford/East Lyme Wastewater Collection, Conveyance, and Treatment Agreement dated October 15, 2021.

Billing and collection.

Water and sewer service will be shut off from all premises having bills in arrears sixty (60) days after payment is due and will not be turned on until all bills in arrears are paid, together with interest, lien charges and other charges for services, and the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for restoring services.

Discharging to sewerage system; operation of septage receiving facility; non-piped sewerage wastes.

- (a) Septage disposal charges shall be as follows:
 - (1) Charges for Waterford and New London customers shall be \$52.8763.44 per one thousand (1,000) gallons, or any part thereof.
 - (2) Charges for all other customers shall be \$79.3280.52 per one thousand (1,000) gallons, or any part thereof.
 - (3) Charges for Filtrate / Grey Water or Customers who have been subjected to bona fide emergency
 - conditions, upon request of their respective town sanitarian or town director of health, and upon verification by the executive director, may deliver non-septic raw sewage for treatment. They shall be charged \$33.8442.30 per one thousand (1,000) gallons, or any part thereof, and an additional administrative charge of \$52.5063.00 per dumping visit regardless of the size of the load actually dumped. Such a condition must be reported to the authority at its next regularly scheduled meeting. Such an arrangement may be granted by the executive director for no more than thirty (30) days. Any extension after that date must be approved by the authority.
